At Back In Motion Chiropractic, we respect your right to receive a “Good Faith Estimate” explaining how much your medical care will cost.

Under the law, health care providers need to give an estimate of the bill for medical items and services to **patients who don’t have insurance or who are not using insurance.**

- You have the right to receive a **Good Faith Estimate** for the total expected cost of any non-emergency items or services. Here at **Back In Motion Chiropractic**, this primarily includes the costs for exams, adjustments, and e-stim therapy.
- You have the right to receive a **Good Faith Estimate** in writing at least 1 business day before your medical service. You may also ask your health care provider for a Good Faith Estimate *before* you schedule an item or service.
- We recommend that you save a copy or picture of your **Good Faith Estimate**.
- If you receive a bill that is at least \$400 more than your **Good Faith Estimate**, you have the right to dispute the bill.
